## EBC student visa assistance programme - Spain

### Introduction

It is still possible to work in Spain without a work permit for 6 to 9 months. This statement is based on our experience placing teachers in Spanish language schools since 2002.

95% of the schools that we send your CV/resume to through our job placement assistance programme do not care whether you have a work permit or not.

**This fact sheet is aimed at people that want an extended stay in Spain (over 9 months) with the possibility of renewing the visa.**

**EBC has been running a pilot project and has been successful in helping students from the USA and Australia get visas. The time validity of the visas we have helped them get varies from 8 months to 1 year.**

### What type of visa will you get?

EBC will give you all the proof of study abroad documentation you need to get a STUDENT VISA.

### How long does the visa last?

The visa can last up to a year. You let us know your preferred visa duration and we will send the appropriate documentation.

### Does the visa allow me to work?

Yes it does as long as your employer files the appropriate paperwork.

### Am I allowed to get the visa?

The EBC visa assistance programme for SPAIN is currently ONLY available to residents/passport holders of the following countries:

- Australia;
- Canada;
- New Zealand;
- United States of America.

**European Union country residents DO NOT need to get a student visa for Spain.**

### Can I apply for the visa after I start the EBC course?

No you can't, you MUST get your visa BEFORE you come to Spain and attend the course.

### How do I apply for the visa?

**IMPORTANT:** Allow yourself at least 6 weeks for the visa process to be completed. If it takes longer, EBC will allow you to move your course date forward.

Follow the 4 steps shown below.

**STEP ONE:** Apply for a course in Madrid.

**STEP TWO:** Contact your nearest Spanish Consulate and find out exactly what personal documentation you will need to submit.

Some of the documents you will need to submit are proof of study abroad, which is where EBC comes in. EBC will give you all the documentation you need in order to justify your Student Visa application.

**STEP THREE:** Send in your deposit for the EBC International TEFL Certificate course in Madrid that you have applied for **AND** send us an email to let us know that you want to apply for a Student Visa.

Once your deposit has been processed, EBC will send you a form to fill out containing your personal details.

You must return the form to us and we will then send you the documents you will need in order to justify your Student Visa application. You will also receive a letter explaining what to do with the documents.

**STEP FOUR:** Take all the documents to the Spanish Consulate and start the application process, after which (we all hope) you will be given your Student Visa.

### Is the visa process guaranteed?

There is an excellent chance that your visa will be approved but, as with everything to do with life, there's no such thing as a sure thing.

You will still be able to find work in Spain with or without this visa which is why applying for the Student Visa is aimed at people that want an extended stay in Spain.
